

BIOGRAPHY:

Robert Faff is a Professor of Finance and the Associate Dean of Research at Bond Business School. Formerly, the Director of Research at the UQ Business School. He has an international reputation in empirical finance research. Prof Faff has secured 14 Australian Research Council grants, with total funding exceeding \$4 million. He has over 320 refereed journal publications, more than 21,000 career citations, and an h-index of 72.

His particular passion is nurturing the career trajectories of early career researchers. Robert has supervised over 40 PhD students to successful completion and examined 50 PhD dissertations.

In addition, Robert is Editor-in-Chief of *Pacific-Basin Finance Journal;* formerly: Editor of *Accounting and Finance* (2002-2011) and Associate Editor of several journals including *Abacus* and *Australian Journal of Management.*
