"Evolution of the fragmentation region in ultrarelativistic heavy ion collisions"

Abstract: I will present a simple classical model of the target fragmentation region that takes into account the effects of gluon saturation. We calculate the subsequent evolution of baryons and the associated radiation. We also confirm that the struck nucleus is compressed by an amount dictated by the saturation scale.
