Eligibility:

Anyone with a PhD in a relevant field of science or interdisciplinary field of science, and who holds a position at a South African university or in a corporate setting, can become an individual Associate. Junior Associates are either staff members at a South African University and enrolled in a PhD programme, or South African Postdocs at a South African University.

Disciplines:

We have Associates in the following fields: Astronomy and Astrophysics, Data Science, Earth Systems Modelling & Climate Change Modelling, Mathematics, Quantitative Biology, Quantitative Finance, Statistics, and Theoretical Physics.

Benefits:

Associates enjoy networking opportunities, participation in research programmes, bursary programmes for students, opportunities to participate in research, training and engagement events, and invitations to present research findings at NITheCS colloquia or mini-schools.

Responsibilities:

Associates are encouraged to participate in the Research Programmes and assist with colloquia / mini-schools / internship supervision. Associates are regularly encouraged to present colloquia and mini-schools.

Meetings:

Associate meetings are held at least once per annum, in-person, online, or in a hybrid format. Research Programme meetings occur more frequently.

NITheCS currently has over 270 Associates representing all relevant fields of science.

Collaboration:

NITheCS encourages collaboration amongst Associates.
