Who

MUST is a research group with a focus on understanding and applying deep learning. Each year, a bootcamp is hosted to get new postgraduate students up to speed. The bootcamp is presented by Prof Marelie Davel, 3 postdocs and 2 senior PhD students in the group.

Material

The bootcamp covers Chapters 1 to 11 of [Understanding Deep Learning](#) by Simon Prince. This covers the fundamentals of Deep Learning, introducing topics such as supervised learning, linear regression, gradient descent, overfitting, and underfitting. It also delves into more advanced concepts including maximum likelihood estimation, optimization algorithms like SGD and Adam, regularization techniques, and convolutional neural networks.

Place

This is a hybrid event, taking place in person on the NWU-Potchefstroom campus along with a virtual option via Zoom.

Fees

The bootcamp is sponsored by NITheCS: *attendance* is free of charge. Optional additional items (textbook, lunches) may be selected when registering.
